Zomi Innkuan USA (ZIUSA), a Zomi Community Organization based in the USA has established a “**ZIUSA Scholarship Program**” to assist Zomi students who are pursuing a higher education. This scholarship is awarded based on academic achievement and is only offered to Zomi students.

The objectives of the “ZIUSA Scholarship Program” are: -

- (1) To help bridge the financial gap that often prevents students from pursuing their dreams of higher education.
- (2) To help Zomi students gain access to complete education by providing financial assistance.

Scholarship award Value

The Scholarship Award is valued at \$2,500 per recipient for those who study in US based institutions and \$1,500 per recipient for those who study outside US institutions. It can be awarded up to two recipients from both US based institutions and outside US institutions at every ZIUSA annual meeting.

Eligibilities and Criteria

Applicant must

1. Have a Basic Education High School Diploma or a High School Equivalent standards set by the government agency.
2. Plan to attend an accredited college, university, or community college, in the upcoming academic year.
3. Must complete application form by due date and provide all required documents.
